GRAPE STOMP

RULES

1. Team captain will be contacted to confirm registration start time prior to the festival. All team members should be present for registration. Please do not call before Wednesday, September 9.
2. Please verify your category when signing in. Checks for winners in all categories will be issued to the captain or designated organization.
3. Stomping consists of two timed minutes. Five persons or less to a team.
4. Only juice, not pulp, produced by stomping will be weighed and recorded.
5. Team captains or designated adult for Student Stomp are responsible for bringing the juice bucket to weigh station, filtering the juice, and verifying the weight with the judges.
6. Use of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Intoxicated individuals will not be allowed to participate.
7. Throwing of grapes or juice will result in disqualification.
8. Please refrain from vulgarity or profanity.
9. No artificial aids, either on hands or feet - bare feet and hands only. It is recommended that all jewelry or breakables be removed before stomping.
10. Teams must be able to stomp on Saturday.
11. Students must present their student identification.
12. NO REFUNDS.
13. Final winners will be determined in each category based on the total juice their team produced.
